## A Brief History of USS Samuel B. Roberts (DE-413)

The SAMUEL B. ROBERTS (IDF-413) was laid down on Doccanes 6, 1943 by Brown Shipbilding Co., Nouston Feets, Insented on January 20, 1944, proprietod by Mrs. Samuel 8, Roberts; and comercissioned on April 29, 1944. LODIR Robert W. Coccland, USRF, in command. The ROBERTS had a displacement of 1745 tons; long-196; heart 987°; deat 1547°; speed 24 kinds; complement 222°; armanesist, 2-5°, 4-40mm, 10-20mm, 3-21° tonpedo bubes 2 delight chainer schola, 6 depth chainer scholars schol

The ROBERTS was named in home of Semuel Booke Roberts, 3r. a Coxewain who was posthumously awarded the Navy Cross for extraordinary hurders white serving on the crew of a landing orest that, despite intense enemy fire, rescued stranded stainings from Guadalcander.



Following a shakedown off Bermuda from May 21 to June 19 and aveilability at Boston Navy Yard, SAMUEL B. ROBERTS departed from Nortotic on July 22, 1944 and transited the Panamic Caralle on July 27 to join the Pooling Feed.

After serving at Pearl Habbr on August 10 she conducted training exercises and esconded several convoys to Enimetols. SAMUEL 8. ROBERTS proceeded to Manus Island where she joined Task Unit 77.4.3, Then steamed for the Leyte Gulf area and commenced operations with the Northern Air Sunner (Grown of Second).
